## **NAR announces Lexington's Janice Mueller as Top 10 Finalist for National Good Neighbor Award**

Mueller has been a member of LBAR for 35 years, and in September 2001 helped found the Makenna Foundation in memory of Makenna David who died of a rare lung disease in 1998. The goal of the Foundation is to raise funds to help make the Kentucky Children's Hospital a benchmark of children's hospitals by providing the necessary equipment and assist in hospital expansion. Since 2001, the Foundation has raised over \$1.2 million for the Kentucky Children's Hospital. The principal broker of RE/MAX Creative, she served as LBAR President in 1990 and 2001. The Good Neighbor Award honors the ongoing volunteer efforts of REALTORS® who are making exceptional contributions to improve the quality of life in communities close to home and around the world.
